

Sydenham Faculty Development Centre (FDC) has been established under the aegis of RUSA, Maharashtra, from the grants received from the MHRD, GOI under the 'Pandit Madan Mohan Malaviya National Mission on Teachers and Teaching' (PMMMNMTT) Scheme. The Centre was established in the year 2018 and within a short span of two years, it has organised 2 Faculty Induction Programmes (FIPs) of one month each, 12 Faculty Development Programmes (FDPs) of ten days each, 2 Research Methodology Workshops of 14 days each and 3 Online Faculty Development Programmes of 5 days each in the various parts of the states of Maharashtra, Gujarat and Goa. These training programmes have benefitted a total of 1898 teacher participants from 25 states and 4 union territories of India.
