Swamiji first enquired with the students the cause of their stress. He helped the students to analyse causes of stress and also advised remedies to overcome stress.


The lecture was followed by a counselling session by Swami Narasimhananda on a one-to-one basis with the students. The students were very much satisfied and happy.



Highlights:

The Accountancy Association of K.J. Somaiya College of Arts and Commerce in collaboration with the BSE Brokers' Forum organized a four day free certification seminar and field visit to Bombay Stock Exchange(BSE) Tower. The BSE Tower is a leading stock exchange located in Mumbai, India. A field visit to BSE provided an opportunity to gain first hand experience on the functioning of the stock exchange and the Indian capital market. Students were provided with a free certification course in order to qualify themselves for the visit, the students who completed the certification were divided into 4 different batches of 35 students each to visit the BSE Tower.

All the students gathered near the BSE Tower which is at a 15-20 minutes walking distance from the CSMT Station at the respective timings of their batches. The student were lead in by the official instructor of school visits at BSE tower, no photography or wandering inside the building was strictly instructed, after frisking of all the students, everyone was lead to the first floor of the building where they were made to que in for the elevator for the 11th floor of the tower to the conference room, the student guide led everyone to the conference room where after settling they met with the speaker. The speaker started by discussing the formation of the BSE and NSE and both of their roles in the Indian security markets Ecosystem, later he covered the topics of how the prices of shares fluctuate according to the demand and supply of the commodities and what the structure of Investment are in the Indian Stock market. Later the Importance of news was discussed affecting the prices of the securities and how long term Investments are safer than small term Investments. Later students were allowed to ask their questions after which the session came to an end. Students were led to the entry gate of the BSE where they clicked a group picture with the bull figure outside the BSE.

The field visit to BSE provided valuable insights into the functioning of a stock exchange and the Indian capital market. The visit helped to gain a better understanding of the role of stock exchanges in the financial sector, the trading and settlement processes, and the technology and systems used to support these operations. Overall, the visit was a valuable learning experience for gaining a deeper understanding of the capital market and the financial sector.



The speaker began by explaining the definition of 'Ratio Analysis' and furthermore explained the related terms i.e 'what is a ratio' and 'accounting ratios'. The speaker also briefed about the Fundamentals of Analysis. Then she spoke about the different types of analysis that are Company Analysis, Economic Analysis and Industry Analysis and also explained the concept of Top-Down Approach of Fundamental Analysis and Bottom-Up Approach of Fundamental Analysis. She then discussed the difference between these two approaches and how they are applied in Fundamental Analysis. She then also explained the Goals of Fundamental Analysis and various steps involved in analysis of fundamentals of a Company, how it is to be carried out and so on. The speaker then explained the different types of ratios such as 1. Liquidity Ratios which include the Current Ratio, Acid Test Ratio, Cash Ratio, Operating Cash Flow Ratio, 2. Financial Leverage Ratios which include the Debt ratio, Interest Coverage Ratio etc ,3. Efficiency Ratios which include the Asset Turnover Ratio and so on, 4. Profitability Ratio and 5. Market Value Ratios. She then summed up her discussion by taking a real life example of the Company 'D-Mart' where she discussed its various ratios, and the core values, vision and mission of the company. The speaker took up a few doubts and queries of the students and finally ended the session.

"War is what happens when language fails."

Diplomacy and dialogue are tools which must be used to avoid war and the loss of lives. The ongoing conflict between Russia and Ukraine is evidence of that fact, where thousands have died and been rendered homeless, resulting in an acute refugee crisis. The war is an event of great importance for world affairs, with Germany playing a significant role in providing refuge to fleeing Ukrainians.

And that was the chosen discussion topic for the guest lecture – Consequences of the Russian-Ukrainian War and its Political Handling in Germany.

The main objective of the seminar was to provide a well-rounded session for students to understand the nuances of the refuge situation and the background,

reasons, and impact of the war.



The session was conducted by Ms. Alexandra Möckel, an alum of University of Leipzig, and currently a teacher of German at the University of Mumbai.

Ms. Alexandra conducted her lecture on the following points:

• Germany as a heterogenous, multi-ethnic immigration country





- The post-WWII economic crisis in Europe which turned Germany into a 'Guest Worker Country'
- Previous refuge policies 2000 Greencard Initiative and the debated refuge policy of 2015 during the European Refuge Crisis
- Political landscape of Russia and Ukraine, factored in with Western and anti-Western influences
- Historical ties between Russia and Ukraine
- The start of the conflict in 2014 with the annexation of Crimea
- Role of international organisations like the European Union and the UN
- Different kinds of aid provided by Germany during the conflict
- The question of Ukrainian refugees, and their treatment in Germany
- Differences in the German refugee policy of 2015, and the refugee policy of now
- Preferential treatment of Ukrainian refugees, over non-European refugees
- Possible solutions and the way forward

The guest lecture was moderated by Dr. Abhinaya Kamble ma'am, and was followed by a Question-and-Answer session. The questions raised by both the teacher and students were satisfactorily answered by Ms. Alexandra. The session had words of praise and appreciation from its participants. The session ended with a vote of thanks motion moved by Dr. Abhinaya ma'am. 25 students have participated in the session. The entire session was conducted in English Language.

Description of the Webinar:

The webinar began with the introduction by the EDC Chairperson, Dr. Shobha Mathew. Further with the introduction of the resource person, Mrs. Anita took over with hands on Market research in Start Ups.

Firstly, she made her point clear that when working in any start-up as a market researcher, one has to understand the significance of data identification & collection, its dissemination, analysis, interpretation & utilisation. She explained further its significance, such as in improving the decision making methods to solve problems holistically. For example, marketing research should be such that it might sell a comb to a bald person.

Identifying one's target audience that is expected to buy the product as a consumer- all considerations revolving around what, by whom, from where, when & how would consumer purchase the product, comprehension of all this by analysing market demand. Moreover, she detailed that it's essential to know competitions & their progress and Unique Selling Point (USP), which can be known by SWOT (Strength, Weakness, opportunities, Threat) analysis, or in simple words, asking questions like "What product they want?", "How will I retain customers?", who are the decision makers?", "Is the market big enough to accept me & my solution?", "What is my capacity?", and so on, in order to know further how to do market segmentation & sectoral stratification wisely (whether vertically acquiring all production chain, or horizontal in different industries) and do the Pain-Point articulation, i.e. innovating a product to solve the problem of consumers.

Also, she taught how to execute marketing planning, like promotion, acquiring funds, evolution of target itself, product portrayal, different mediums for the same (for instance, media & social media influencers), landscape expansion and at last but not the least, customers' feedback.






At the end, she briefed about how to do cost-beneficial market research, namely by utilising Google, its AdSense, Surveys, LinkedIn pages, surfing about the competitors, gaining information via reading, hiring interns as freshly educated and inexpensive intellectual labour, etc.

Lastly, the session was thrown open for question-answer, when student turned out to be doubtful due to an already well detailed & comprehensible presentation of Mrs. Anita.

- 10. Differentiation between HR's activities & practices







The guest lecture ended with a question-and-answer session. The guest lecture was an eye-opening session towards a better life.







The guest then began his lecture, starting with cybercrimes. He explained various cybercrimes, laws related to the crimes, and which of the crimes can attract a penalty fine or even having to go behind the bars. He then went on to social media. What it is and various social media platforms. He spoke about oversharing on social media with hilarious yet realistic examples of how people share every bit of their life on social media and how can it create problems for the person. Crimes on social media were mentioned and how they can affect a person's mental health. Dopamine crash was discussed, i.e. how a crash of dopamine levels can be confused with depression. Social media or any activity one likes can give a dopamine spike, and when there is a pause or abrupt stop to it, it can lead to a dip in dopamine levels, which gets confused with depression. Related to cybercrimes (on social media), things like various platforms or mobile applications tracking our locations without our consent or knowledge were also touched upon. It led to the point that how privacy on social media, or even when you purchase a device, is stolen, that privacy is a myth.

He ended his lecture by talking about social comparison on social media, Fear of missing out (FOMO), etc. and how we start to compare our lives with that of others on social media. It was followed by a discussion session.

Radhika Taylor from SYBA brought the fun and informative guest lecture to an end with her vote of thanks. 50 students benefitted from this lecture.
